The Fort Rosecrans Memorial Day Committee, comprised of War Veterans Organizations, their Auxiliaries, and patriotic groups, has conducted the Memorial Services at Fort Rosecrans National Cemetery in San Diego for over 100 years.

## Flag Placement Etiquette:

- Flags should be placed uniformly, approximately one foot in front of and centered on the grave marker or headstone.
- Always follow flag etiquette; never lay flags on the ground, and only use flags in excellent condition.
- After placing the flag, pause to say the veteran's name and thank them for their service.
